

10. Clothes with holes above the knee are not to be worn to school.
11. Boys are not to wear earrings at school. Students are not to wear nose rings, tongue pins, lip pins, naval pins/rings, or other similar items are prohibited.
11. Boys' hair must not come below the bottom of the T-shirt collar in the back and sides, or below the eyebrows in front. All students' hair should be neat, clean and well-groomed. The administration reserves the right to request students to alter their hair length and/or style if in their opinion it could be a disruption to the school environment or an endangerment to the health and safety to a student, other students or employees.

Any student deemed in violation of the dress code will be required to find clothing that meets the code or will be sent home (suspended) to correct the situation.
