

students will begin to know educators who will be working with them in the future. We will also facilitate communication between head start personnel and parents as much as possible.

- **We will ensure that information related to school and parents programs, meetings, and other activities is sent to the parents of participating children in a format and, to the extent practicable, in a language the parents can understand.**

We will send out notes and fliers to parents in advance of programs and events in which they may participate in order to build a more secure bond between home and school. For example, a student art show will necessitate a note to parents, a paragraph in our school newsletter, a blurb on our website, and will be placed on our school sign well in advance of the event. Additionally, we will ensure that this information is disseminated in the language spoken in the child's home.

- **We will commit to providing any reasonable support necessary to ensure that the parents of our students have the opportunity to participate in the education of their children.**

Faculty and staff will be available to answer questions and provide assistance to parents whenever needed. Ours is a school family, and it is our belief that family supports one another in every way.

#### Accessibility

- **To the extent possible, we will provide full opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children.**

The Winston County School System provides policies which delineate procedures for working with parents under the abovementioned circumstances. These policies will be strictly observed; furthermore, this work will be undertaken with love, concern, and empathy. The staff places the well being of children before all else.
