Snacks

There is a snack store available for students who wish to purchase snacks during an assigned time each day. Students also have the option of bringing snacks from home; however, bottled drinks will not be allowed on campus

State-owned Textbooks

The textbooks used at school are normally those that are state adopted. Such textbooks are not the property of the students but must be accounted for by both the student and the school. For this reason, any textbook that is damaged or lost must be paid for by the student to whom the book is issued.

At the beginning of the year, each student receives textbooks that he/she will need for his/her course. Fees for lost or damaged textbooks will be paid to the school bookkeeper in the office, and a receipt will be issued to that student.

Parent/Teacher Conferences

Teachers are available for parent-teacher conferences. Parents should telephone for conference appointments one day in advance. In no case does a parent have the right to enter a teacher's room without first having obtained permission from the office. This procedure is for the safety and protection of all students.

Visitors

Students from other schools will not be allowed to visit on this campus during the school day. Visitors who come to school on business must first report to the principal's office.
