

School Day Insurance

School insurance is available to all students. A packet will be available for each student on the first day of classes. Purchase of the program is optional.

Teacher Authority

Students are expected to comply with all reasonable requests made by teachers. A request will be held reasonable unless it is immoral, illegal, or personally degrading. Students should recognize the authority of all faculty members (both elementary and high school) and their right and duty to enforce school policy.

Campus Cleanliness

Cleanliness is everyone's concern and responsibility. Waste receptacles are available and their use is imperative. Students will be asked to help in maintaining the environment by picking up paper or helping to do daily classroom maintenance as part of their character education. Maintaining our facilities is everyone's concern. Time spent performing these types of activities will in no way be allowed to take away from academics.

Medication

School personnel cannot dispense Tylenol or other OTC medications to a child even if the parent has requested or approved it by phone. If it becomes necessary for a student to take any form of medication at school, parents must either come to school to administer the medication or sign the proper release forms with the school nurse. **Children are never to bring medications to school themselves.** Parents should caution their children about giving cough drops, Tylenol, or any other OTC medication to a friend. Children often have allergies to medications that cause severe reactions. If children are found to be giving any medication to others, they are subject to suspension and/or expulsion from school.

Absences and Excuses

Excused Absences

All student absences shall be designated as either excused or unexcused. A student shall be excused for absence from school for the following reasons:

1. Student is too ill to attend school.
2. Inclement weather that would be dangerous for students to attend school as determined by the Superintendent of Schools.
3. Legal quarantine or legal requirement.
4. Death in the immediate family.
5. Emergency conditions as determined by the Superintendent of Schools or principal.
